Agenda Workshop Minutes

THE BLACK MOUNTAIN TOWN COUNCIL held their regular agenda workshop meeting on Thursday, February 9, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the board room of Town Hall, 160 Midland Avenue, Black Mountain NC.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor C. Michael Sobol opened the meeting and welcomed those in attendance. Town Manager, Josh Harrold, presented the proposed agenda to the Town Council.

Mayor Sobol recommended removing Item 5E – Agreement between the Department Of Transportation and Town of Black Mountain for EB5547 Section B from the Consent Agenda. Mayor Sobol expressed concern with the project and a desire to delay moving forward with the agreement. Council Member Hay suggested that Item 5E be moved to Unfinished Business in order to allow further discussion.

The Manager continued his presentation of the agenda. There was some discussion concerning Items 8D and 8E - Community Waste Reduction Grant Application and Community Recycling Grant Application. Mayor Sobol requested that Public Works Director provide the tonnage and tipping fees to the Town Council at or before the February 13, 2023 Regular Session Meeting.


