VI. Old Business

- a. Update on First Street/Midland Sharrow Julia Weatherford
The sharrow does not meet Fonta Flora Trail. Public Works will create the sharrow in-house. Issue where Village Way greenway dumps on Charlotte Street. Holes from past planters that were installed but nothing grows in them so there are holes that need to be filled. They are a dangerous obstruction to bikes and foot traffic. Making a bike ramp so bicycles can easily and safely move onto the sharrow. Jake will look into it. TC decided it will be a sharrow and not a multiuse path. Pam King is on Fonta Flora Trail.
- b. Update on I-40 Underpass Julia Weatherford
To meet DOT requirements. Does MOU mention who keeps barrels cleared of brush? The other barrels are collecting brush which diverts water onto greenway. Jake will look into if Town takes care of debris removal. Jake said the Town Council budget was approved for painting after DOT paving requirements are filled.
